Tips

- Since all students are under 13, parents must set up their account.
- **Emails** - Only enter emails of family, friends, and neighbors that you want to ask for donations. Ask your parents for help. Do not email each other or enter email addresses to fake/personal accounts.
- **Acts of Kindness** - Encourage students to focus on quality over quantity.

What is an Act of Kindness? Something that positively impacts another person or place.

Examples: picking up trash around a park, writing letters of appreciation to mail carriers, custodians, healthcare and other service workers, telling a sibling what they mean to you, donating gently used clothing, books, or toys.

What isn't an Act of Kindness?

While nice, everyday chores and things you're responsible for are not acts of kindness. Examples: completing homework, feeding pets, putting your things away.
